You could wear this T-shirt which, instead of advertising someone's fashion label, may help you communicate your concern over this still unresolved injustice in our land and your respect for the ideals and people of Parihaka.

Arohamai : Front Logo. Red on Black. Arohamai means "sorry" or "forgive me". We don't want to make anyone feel guilty. This T-shirt is only for those who identify, peace-makers who want to personally help put right our nation's wrong-doing. In this instance, the wrongs are detailed on the back of the shirt.
